DESIGNATION OF CENTRALIZED EXAMINATION STATION

Ocean Carriers will designate a Centralized Examination Station (CES) for all Non-Intrusive Inspections (NII) and physical examinations of inbound and outbound cargo conducted by A-TCET. Ocean Carriers will designate a Centralized Examination Station (CES) for all "Back-in" and physical examinations of inbound cargo conducted by Agriculture. Select one CES (for each type of examination only). Carriers calling on terminals in both New York and New Jersey in the port may select one CES in New Jersey and one CES in New York for each type of examination (Agriculture – A-TCET/NII).
